Application Selection

Due to time and space restraints, we will only have 40 acts maximum. Each act will have four weeks from the application deadline to rehearse. On February 17th, we will be holding auditions for qualification into the Talent Show. Please make sure your act is well planned, rehearsed, and original.

Talent Show Rules

- 1) Only Socrates Academy students (grades 3-7) may participate in Socrates' Got Talent.
- 2) Each act is limited to a maximum performance time of 3 minutes.
- 3) Each Group Act must identify a Group Leader that will act as the main contact for the group and is responsible for coordinating with and responding to Student Council/ Cultural Arts Committee.
- 4) Socrates Academy will provide a standard grand piano and sound system. You must provide any additional instruments, props, audiovisual support, etc. that will be used during your performance.
- 5) All contestants must arrive and be ready to perform at 6pm on Saturday, February 25th. Contestants arriving late may be disqualified.
- 6) All performances must be in good taste. The Student Council/ Cultural Arts Committee have final authority to decline acts deemed inappropriate.
